TIMELINE Teytexen Village SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT



1854

The Snuneymuxw First Nation signs the Sarlequun Snuneymuxw (Douglas)
Treaty of 1854 with Canada. Village sites were to be surveyed and protected for our community.

2001

Snuneymuxw Chief and Council and Canada initiate research into a Teytexen Village claim.

JUNE 27, 2007

Canada agrees to negotiate the Teytexen Village claim.

MARCH 4, 2015

Canada offers to settle the Teytexen Village claim for \$5,051,591.

Dissatisfied, Snuneymuxw Chief and Council continue to advocate for a more comprehensive and just resolution.

1860

While the northern part of Teytexen Village is reserved for Snuneymuxw First Nation, the southern portion is never protected or reserved by Canada.

This southern land is taken from the Snuneymuxw People and given to newcomers.

JANUARY 31, 2003

The "Teytexen Village Specific Claim" is filed.

JULY 25, 2007

Snuneymuxw agrees to enter negotiations with Canada.

JANUARY, 2025

A \$42 million settlement from Canada is presented to Snuneymuxw members.
