Key Responsibilities:

- Provide **direct and indirect patient care**, including assessments, diagnoses, treatments, and ongoing management of chronic and acute conditions.
- Deliver **culturally safe**, **trauma-informed**, **and low-barrier care** in accordance with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of BC (CPSBC) standards.
- Participate in **Snuneymuxw Hulit Lelum Family Doctor administrative services**, including chart reviews, medical audits, and peer reviews.
- Collaborate with allied health professionals to provide holistic, team-based care.
- Home Visits with clients and family.

Qualifications:

- Licensed (or eligible for licensure) with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of BC (CPSBC).
- Commitment to cultural humility and working with Indigenous communities.
- Experience in primary care, addiction medicine, and chronic disease management is an asset.
- Ability to work collaboratively in an interdisciplinary setting.
